- 1. How many birds frequently visit the Barataria-Terrebonne National Estuary area? 400 different species of birds visit the BTNE area.
- 2. What major body of water do the birds have to fly over to get to Louisiana? The birds fly over the Gulf of Mexico.
- 3. What two things do the barrier islands do for us? Barrier islands: a. protect us from storms b. are a habitat for birds
- How many times a year do the birds fly to Louisiana? In what seasons? Birds fly to Louisiana twice a year; in spring and fall.
- 5. What does the term "migration" mean? Migration means when living things periodically move from one region to another; they need a place to rest.
- 6. Why do the birds have to stop in this area? The birds have just flown over the Gulf of Mexico and are extremely tired and hungry.
- 7. When does a "fallout" occur? A Fallout means when some type of weather condition makes hundreds of birds to land in a certain area.



- 8. Has Grand Isle ever been a part of the "fallout" area? Yes, Grand Isle has been part of the fallout area.
- 9. Why are trees planted in the BTNE? One reason trees are planted is so birds can have a place to rest and nest after their long flight across the Gulf of Mexico.
- 10. Why did Congress pass laws to prohibit the killing of some birds?Hunters were killing all species of birds and causing some animals

to become threatened or extinct.

- 11. What was DDT used for? DDT was used as a pesticide to get rid of insects.
- 12. How was it harmful? DDT traveled up the food chain and bioaccumulation occurred, which caused the birds to die.
- 13. Why was DDT outlawed in the early 70's? DDT was outlawed because it was killing the birds.
- 14. Where does the Coastal Louisiana Bird Trail begin? The birding trail begins in the Bararatia-Terrebonne National Estuary.
